Hello W2D2 participants,

W2D2 starts in just over a day! Let's get right to it:

- For the W2D2 Schedule of Videoconferences, go to <https://cern.ch/w2d2> and choose the Videocons button. The schedule (in UTC) is there! Use a good online Time Zone Converter, e.g. [timeanddate](https://www.timeanddate.com/), to convert to local time. Check to find your videoconference(s) and be sure it all works for you. If not, please contact Ken as soon as you can and we will try to adjust.
- All videoconferences are limited to 30 minutes or less, including transition time from one conference to the next. Your videoconference starts at the time shown on the schedule and ends promptly 30 minutes later.
- We have only one videoconference channel, which you can access from the Indico page at <https://indico.cern.ch/event/1478961/>: choose the blue Join button to the right below the title banner.
- Please do not share the videoconference link with anyone unless it is needed.
- Remember, teachers pick the datasets for their students to use. Instructions are in Memo 3.
- A slight correction is needed. One of our teachers picked up this error in the video describing the CMS measurement: "... at approx 6 mins 00 second we are told that the theta angle is always the shortest angle [sic] from the positive z axis measuring anticlockwise... I'm guessing the word anticlockwise was a slip of the tongue." Quite right. Theta is measured as the shortest angle from the +z-axis in *either direction*. We'll need to fix that video for next year.
